

# CRS' GLOBAL MALARIA PROGRAMS

In fiscal year 2019, CRS implemented a **\$154 million portfolio** of malaria programs worldwide, reaching more than **86 million beneficiaries** in 12 countries.



## WHAT WE DO



### PREVENT & SUPPORT

**113+ million**

insecticide-treated bed nets distributed by CRS through health ministries in The Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Madagascar, Niger, Nigeria, and Senegal.



### TEST, DIAGNOSE, & TREAT

**3,168 community**

community health workers trained by the Ministry of Health in Benin, with oversight from CRS, in integrated community case management of malaria, diarrhea, and pneumonia.



### COLLECT DATA USING MOBILE APPS

**Approximately 60 percent** of CRS' malaria programs use mobile technology to improve speed and accuracy of data collection, enable simple analysis and use of complex data, or increase adherence to malaria treatment guidelines.



### MOVE TOWARD ELIMINATION

CRS has supported malaria programming in The Gambia over the last 14 years, which has contributed to a **97.5% reduction** in malaria prevalence from 4% in 2010 to 0.1% in 2017. The Gambia is now a step closer to eliminating malaria.



**Since 2014**, CRS has supported national malaria control programs in six countries (Cameroon, Guinea, Mali, Niger, Nigeria and The Gambia) in the scale-up of seasonal malaria chemoprevention. Over the last 5 years, CRS has supported the distribution of **22 million doses** to children under five years of age.
