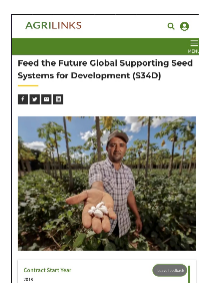

S34D on Agrilinks



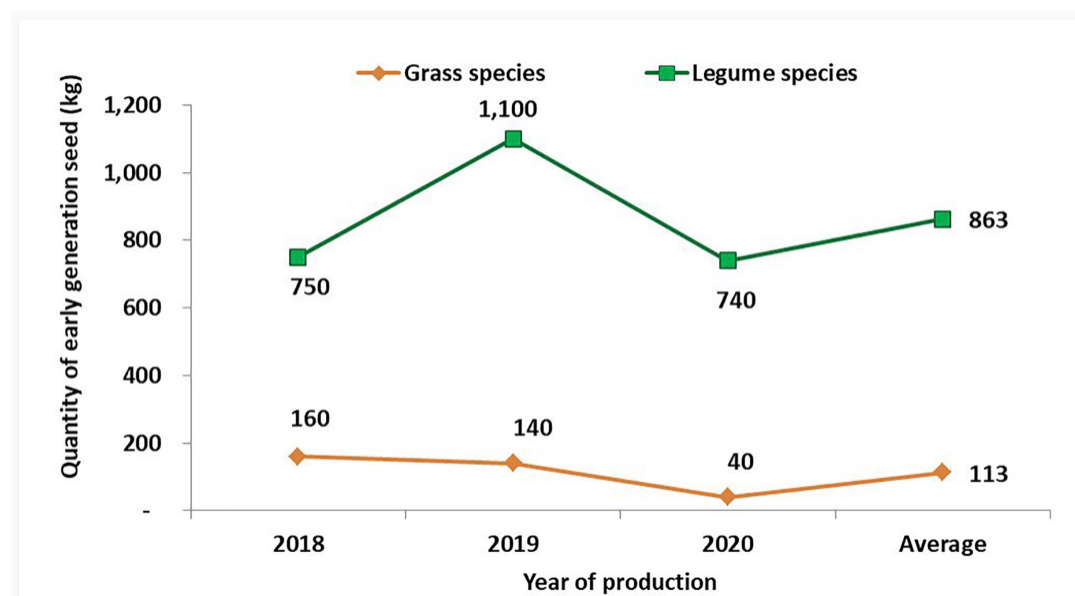

Forage seed system performance of Ethiopia: An overview based on key indicators

This study, recently published in CABI Reviews, provides a framework to monitor forage seed system performance in developing countries. Inclusive of six major indicators and 26 sub-indicators, the template takes into consideration the pluralistic nature of seed systems in the Ethiopian context. Key opportunities and recommendations for development partners, practitioners, national stakeholders, and decision-makers active in the Ethiopian forage sector are provided.
