



Emergency Assistance for FLOOD AFFECTED HOUSEHOLDS in Pakistan

In response to the devastating flood of 2022, CRS and its local partners implemented a 9-month project in **Sindh** and **Baluchistan** (September 2022–June 2023) with the financial support from USAID's Bureau for Humanitarian Assistance (BHA). The project's goal was to help **26,692 flood-affected households** meet their basic needs through cash assistance, improved hygiene practices, and access to safe and dignified WASH infrastructure and services.
