Key Terms

Direct Participant

An individual who actively participates in a project activity and is personally identifiable.

Indirect Participant

An individual who receives a benefit indirectly through a direct project participant.

Direct Results

Results achieved through implementation of CRS projects.

Influenced Results

Results achieved through CRS' influence on other actors such as government, partners, peer organizations, private sector firms, and community members. These results do not occur through CRS-funded project implementation.

Drivers of Scale (Types of influenced results)

Institution-driven scale

Scaling that occurs through institutions that CRS influences, such as government agencies, private sector firms, and UN agencies.

Peer/partner-driven scale

Scaling that occurs through replication, adaptation or expansion of CRS approaches by CRS partners or other NGOs or INGOs.

Community-driven scale

Scaling that occurs through the spread of activities and practices from CRS project participants to other individuals, households or communities.



Participant Trends Over Time












































