Protect Lifesaving and Life-Affirming International Assistance

A Catholic pro-life approach to U.S. international assistance goes beyond charity. It is a strategic investment that has a profound impact on human life, dignity and global stability.

Catholic Relief Services stands ready to build on a strong history of successful collaboration with the U.S. government and enhance the Church's expression of charity and the American values of leadership and service.

Please protect lifesaving international assistance by telling the administration to reverse terminations of CRS programs, opposing rescissions of previously appropriated funds for lifesaving humanitarian and development assistance, and robustly funding poverty-reducing international assistance in fiscal year 2026 appropriations.

With intention and consistency, **international** assistance achieves significant results.

Faith knows

The Shared Future program in Iraq supported the return of religious and ethnic minorities who fled formerly ISIS-controlled areas. By providing business development alongside the tools for diverse groups to rebuild trust, the project increased residents' intention to stay in their villages from 70% to 92%, ultimately advancing stability. Regrettably, the program's termination—in its final year—disrupted the codification of these gains.

In Latin America, CRS' efforts to support local Church partners have enabled lifesaving assistance to reach over 284,000 people. Across five countries in Central and South America, locally led emergency response teams have found that the percentage of households able to meet their own basic food needs has increased from 16% to 71%. Unfortunately, several of the awards catalyzing these changes were recently terminated.

Rescissions and reductions to international assistance accounts threaten the long-term viability of crucial lifesaving and life-affirming programs and undermine decades of work to establish the U.S. as a leader in serving the global community and fostering a more peaceful and prosperous world.
