





In response to the devastating flood of 2022, CRS and its local partners implemented a 9-month project in Sindh and Baluchistan (September 2022-June 2023) with the financial support from USAID's Bureau for Humanitarian Assistance (BHA). The project's goal was to help 26,692 flood-affected households meet their basic needs through cash assistance, improved hygiene practices, and access to safe and dignified WASH infrastructure and services.
