MOVE TOWARD ELIMINATION

CRS has supported malaria programming in The Gambia over the last 13 years, which has contributed to a **95%** reduction in malaria prevalence from 4% in 2010 to 0.2% in 2014. The Gambia is now a step closer to eliminating malaria.

CRS has supported national malaria control programs in scaling up seasonal malaria chemoprevention in Guinea, Mali, Niger and The Gambia. In 2016, 11 million doses were distributed, reaching 2.8 million children. Malaria cases were reduced by 49% in Mali.
