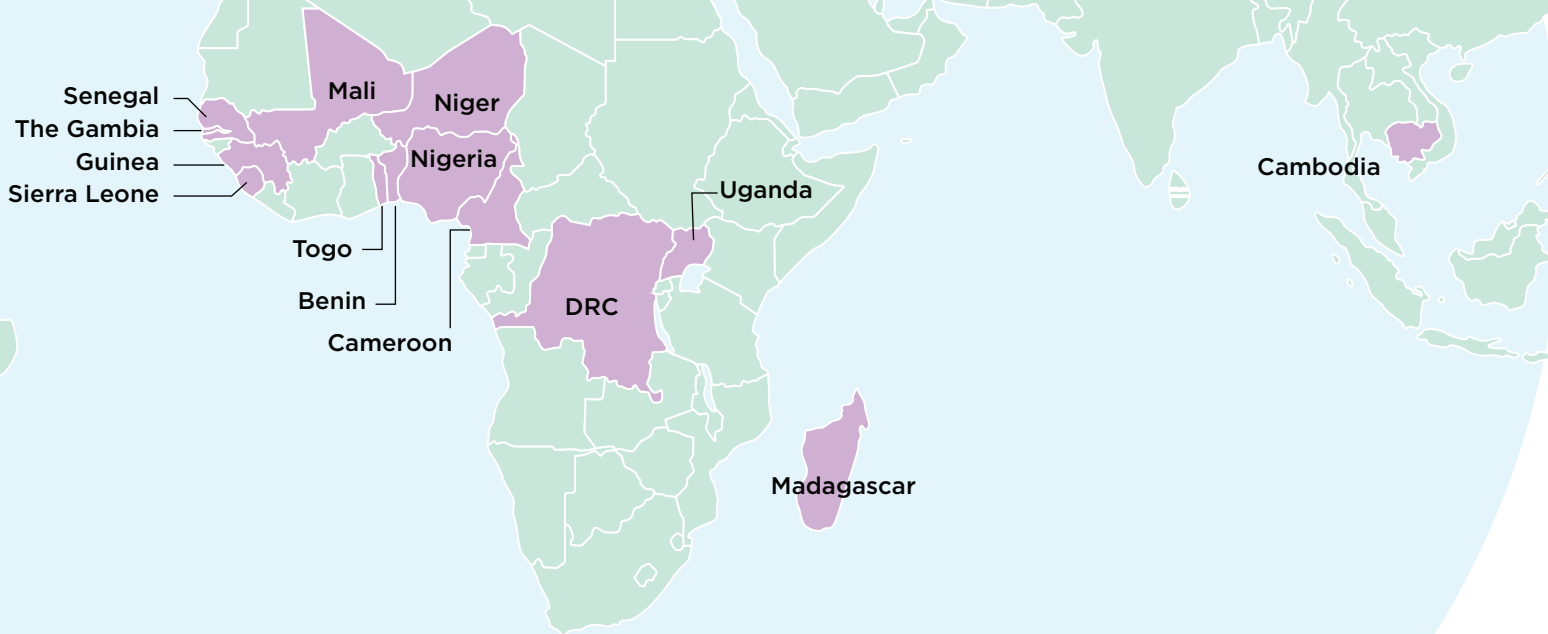


# CRS' GLOBAL MALARIA PROGRAMS

In 2017, CRS implemented a \$256 million portfolio of 16 programs worldwide, reaching 65 million beneficiaries in 14 countries.

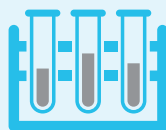


## WHAT WE DO



### PREVENT & SUPPORT

**26+ million** insecticide-treated bed nets distributed by CRS through health ministries in The Gambia, Ghana, Guinea, Madagascar, Niger, and Senegal



### TEST, DIAGNOSE & TREAT

**2,439 community** health workers trained by the Ministry of Health in Guinea, with oversight from CRS, in correct testing, diagnosis, and treatment of malaria.



### COLLECT DATA USING MOBILE APPS

**60 percent** of CRS' malaria programs use mobile technology to improve speed and accuracy of data collection, enable simple analysis and use of complex data, or increase adherence to malaria treatment guidelines.



### MOVE TOWARD ELIMINATION

CRS has supported malaria programming in The Gambia over the last 13 years, which has contributed to a **95% reduction** in malaria prevalence from 4% in 2010 to 0.2% in 2014. The Gambia is now a step closer to eliminating malaria.

**CRS** has supported national malaria control programs in scaling up seasonal malaria chemoprevention in Guinea, Mali, Niger and The Gambia. In 2016, **11 million doses** were distributed, reaching **2.8 million children**. Malaria cases were reduced by **49%** in Mali.
