- Assist in recruitment of parish, diocesan and community speaking engagements
- > Use your networks to engage other clergy and to obtain speaking engagements.

Global Fellow Associates

- Active or retired priest or deacon with a passion for social justice, excitement to join a community of like-minded clergy, and an interest in CRS
- > Commit to a minimum of three speaking engagements within your own parish and/or diocese
- > Participate in 1 overseas immersion trip
- ➤ Participate in a CRS orientation and other training opportunities
