



Emergency Relief for Flood Affected Households in Pakistan

In response to the flood emergency in Sindh in 2022, Catholic Relief Services (CRS), with the financial assistance of the International Organization for Migration (IOM), has provided support to the flood-affected population since December 2022. The six-month project provided support in District Jacobabad and Dadu through Cash for Shelter, essential NFIs, and the restoration of community-level WASH infrastructure.
