



Introduction



Saving is a habit that children must learn.

From savings groups we learn how to save, every 8 or 15 days for our school materials, shoes, or to help buying food for our home.

We can also learn to be leaders in the group.

Our mothers and fathers can help us take care of our money to have it ready for the day of the meeting. We need their permission to meet with the promoter in a safe place; she will be responsible for taking care of us.



During each meeting of our savings group, the promoter can give us a drawing to color and to learn about an important topic.

What does saving mean?




Saving is thinking about the future

Buying things that are not necessary, like sodas and candy




