CRS' GLOBAL MALARIA PROGRAMS

In fiscal year 2018, CRS implemented a **\$138 million portfolio** of malaria programs worldwide, reaching more than **70 million beneficiaries** in 13 countries.

Approximately 60 percent

of CRS' malaria programs use mobile technology to improve speed and accuracy of data collection, enable simple analysis and use of complex data, or increase adherence to malaria treatment guidelines.



MOVE TOWARD ELIMINATION

CRS has supported malaria programming in The Gambia over the last 13 years, which has contributed to a **95%** reduction in malaria prevalence from 4% in 2010 to 0.2% in 2014. The Gambia is now a step closer to eliminating malaria.



Since 2014, CRS has been supporting national malaria control programs in five countries (Cameroon, Guinea, Mali, Niger, and The Gambia) in the scale-up of seasonal malaria chemoprevention. In 2016, malaria cases were reduced by **39%** in Mali and **57%** in The Gambia.
