On June 20, invite your community to text CALL CONGRESS to 677-68 so they can access advocacy resources to support refugees, many of whom are living on the frontlines of the climate emergency.
July	Prepare to meet with members of Congress. Share best practices for meeting with congressional members in-person or virtually with your community. Learn by visiting crs.org/act .
Congressional Recess August	Get your community to meet with members of Congress. With congressional members being home, now is a great time to invite them to your community event or schedule a meeting with them. Reach out to your CRS staff member to prepare to meet or engage with your congressional office in other ways.
