World Day of Migrants and Refugees Sep 24	Day of Social Media and Advocacy. The effects of climate change can be devastating, often leaving families with no choice but to leave their homes in search of food and work. Pope Francis' message for World Day of Migrants and Refugees—free to choose whether to migrate or stay—calls us to walk alongside our sisters and brothers who face the prospect of leaving their homeland. Mobilize: On Sept. 24, use social media channels to invite your community to address the impacts of climate change by signing up for CRS' Email Congress Day—coming up on Oct. 4. Download the Email Congress Day save the date messages and photos
Feast of Saint Francis of Assisi Oct 4	Participate in Email Congress Day. Advocate: On the feast of Saint Francis of Assisi, advocate for solutions that address the impact of climate change by emailing your members of Congress to fund international development and humanitarian aid, especially within the Green Climate Fund and Development Assistance. Text CLIMATE to 677-68 to start your email. Engage: Share this action with your community and invite them to advocate as well.

Join CRS, in partnership with Caritas Internationalis, for a week of action to care for our common home as one planet, one family. Lead: Throughout the week, CRS will share different actions your community can take to make an impact for our global family. Ahead of the Week of Action, invite your community to: Subscribe to learn more about CRS' campaigns on climate change and hunger by texting ACT to 677-68. Key Dates	Actions
Advent December	Live in global solidarity with the CRS Advent Giving Tree. Serve: Invite your community to set up a CRS Advent Giving Tree to meditate on the birth of Jesus into poverty and on how this reflects the reality of many families today. Each tree ornament includes items that represent actual goods and services provided to people CRS serves around the world. 	Promote: Share the CRS Advent Calendar and invite your community to pray and reflect each day in anticipation of Jesus' birth: crs.org/advent-calendar.
Grow the Movement January	Take bold action in the new year. Shepherd: Inspire your community to join a nationwide movement of people dedicated to addressing the root causes of poverty. Ask them to pledge to build a better world through prayer, giving and action by texting ACT to 677-68. They'll receive a prayer for peace right away as their next step toward creating lasting change.
Ash Wednesday Feb 14	Bring Lent to Life. Accompany: During the year of parish revival for the Eucharist, use CRS Rice Bowl resources to engage your community in a transformative Lenten journey to encounter Christ in our global family. Learn together how the Eucharist—the Bread of Life—calls us to share bread for life with our sisters and brothers. Pass out Rice Bowls and share the Lenten resources found at crsricebowl.org.

Easter <i>Mar 31</i>	Celebrate the joy of Easter! Rejoice: Guide your community to turn in their CRS Rice Bowl donations from their in-person or virtual collection and share how their Lenten alms made a global impact. Or they can submit their gifts at crsricebowl.org/give.
Spring Recess Visits <i>March-April</i>	Let your voice be heard. Serve: Advocate for critical issues that affect our global family by participating in legislative visits during March and April, when members of Congress will be working from their home states or districts. Contact your CRS staff member to learn more and register to participate in Spring Recess visits. Key Dates	Actions
Earth Day Apr 22	For our one planet, one family. Activate: In preparation for Laudato Si' Week in May, encourage your community to take a pledge and commit to transforming our world for our one planet, one family by texting ACT to 677-68.
Laudato Si' Week May 19-26	 Caring for our common home. Join us during Laudato Si' Week in supporting our global family facing the challenges of climate change. Empower: Leading up to the week, encourage your community to: Text CALL CONGRESS to 677-68 to sign up to participate in Call Congress Day on May 21. Follow CRS on social media and watch for updates on ways to take action. Visit crs.org/act for additional opportunities to learn more about our campaigns and get involved.
Call Congress Day May 21	Call Congress Day. Advocate: Take collective action alongside Catholics and others of goodwill by calling your members of Congress—asking them to address the effects of climate change and support people who are most vulnerable to its impacts. Text CALL CONGRESS to 677-68 to participate in this exciting day of advocacy.

June-July	Register and prepare for August Recess visits. Contact your CRS staff member to learn more and to register to participate in August Recess. Invite your community to register as well. Then visit CRS' Action Center for tools and resources to help you and your community prepare: crs.org/act.
Congressional Recess August	Join in unity during August Recess. Influence: Participate in August Recess visits and share about the success of your legislative meetings with your community. Then, ask your networks to help amplify your message to Congress by using the template messages and photos provided on CRS' Communications and Social Media Kit at crs.org/communications-kit.
