CRS has been working diligently on the "<u>Be Unafraid to Share the</u>
<u>Journey</u>" sub-campaign which speaks to the US audience and proposes
that transformation of the heart is possible when an authentic

"encounter" occurs. In addition to the photo and video shoot with celebrity photographer Jeremy Cowart, CRS promoted a successful three-city media truck tour. During these events, where we brought refugees and anti-migrant citizens together to discuss their fears around migration, we witnessed (and recorded) a number of moments of transformation of heart and change of mind.

Two weeks ago, Catholic Relief Services, the Be Unafraid Project, and the power of encounter were showcased on **Amanpour and Company** which aired on CNN International and PBS stations throughout the US.

Thank you for all you do to help the most vulnerable members of our global human family. A healthy and happy 2019 to you!


