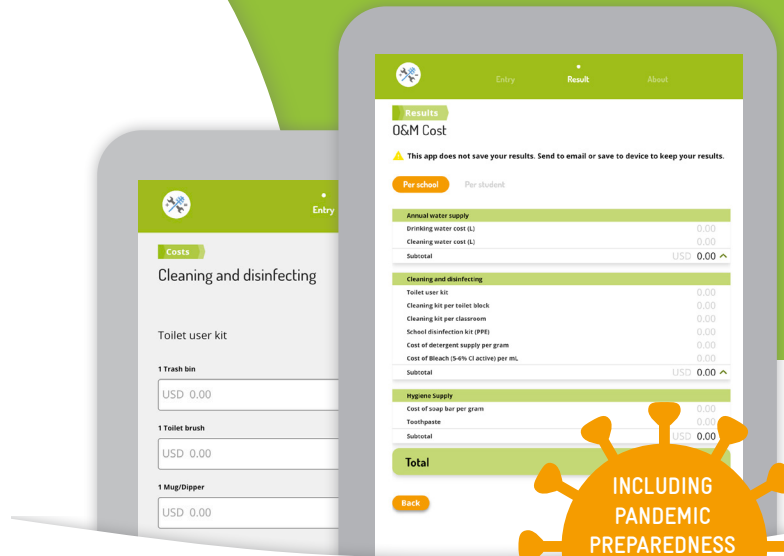

WHAT IS THE APP FOR?

This tool provides support in calculating the costs for operation and maintenance (O&M) for schools in the areas of water, sanitation, and hygiene (WASH). This calculation includes the calculation of new requirements in response to COVID-19.

The app follows WHO/ UNICEF/ UNESCO recommendations on:

- > DRINKING WATER
- > SANITATION
- > PERSONAL AS WELL AS ENVIRONMENTAL HYGIENE



WHO CAN USE IT?

The app has been developed for school heads and managers responsible for planning on school, district/division, and national level. The app can also be used by different development partners and NGOs working to support the education sector on WASH in Schools implementation and programming.



HOW TO GET THE APP?

The first step is to download the app and, once installed, the app can be used offline. The basic requirement is a device with an operating system of either Android Kitkat 4.4 or later versions and iOS 11.4 to the current versions.



HOW DOES IT WORK?

Information on number of students, number of toilets, classrooms, and number of school days per year has to be provided and together with the cost of locally available materials.

The app will automatically calculate the annual budget needed to manage WinS O&M in compliance with global recommendations.
